Important Notice Music in Churches for Weddings, Funerals etc

The Diocese of Down & Connor state that ALL music used in a church must be licensed – the license provided **ONLY** covers liturgical music. Pop Music, Irish folk Music, Football anthems etc should **not be used at any event** in the church, as these are covered by a separate copyright and may leave the Parish/Diocese open to legal repercussions.

Using a song or music in a church service or act of worship, even if its a non profit event - wedding, funeral etc, is considered a public performance and reproduction which requires permission under our license. Furthermore - to legally use a copyrighted song, you need the permission of the copyright holder. There is a minimum fine of £5000.
