The Chairperson welcomed members to the meeting, the last before the summer recess. The last month has been busy with the sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation as well as Saul Sunday and the Sacred Heart Procession. Vivienne extended thanks to all who had been involved ensuring that all went well.

3. Adoption of Minutes from previous Meeting 12th May 2025.

• Readers/EMHC Training Day

The Readers and Eucharistic Ministers training days have been postponed until September due to the absence of clergy.

Fr. Brankin will bring the Cemetery Policy Terms of Reference before the Finance Committee. There are four definitions of a parishioner, and no non-parishioner can be buried in any of the cemeteries due to the shortage of space. The Terms of Reference were agreed - Fr. Brankin will run them past the people of Kilclief. Vivienne will pass it to Amanda to hold until it is passed by the people of Kilclief and then it can go out to parishioners. During the last week Amanda got a request for information from one of the undertakers about a niche in the columbarium and enquiring how many remains can go in a niche. Each niche will hold at least two remains, but the niches are being measured. The niches are leasehold – the length of the leasehold is not known.

Student Mass 2025

The Student Mass was held on 16th May. There was a good number of students at the Mass. Last year we worked with the Gaelic Club, and they came to the Mass.

There was a good turnout - it was good to see the First Communicants there and it was special to have the Sacred Heart Statue. We could look at suggestions for next year. Jackie suggested maybe we could have a marquee with tea and refreshments, and we could have an ice-cream van as we have done in the past. The bishop is keen to keep the annual pilgrimage going. The Diocesan Novena to the Sacred Heart will run from 19th to 27th June, the Feast of the Sacred Heart.

He would like to begin in Saul and will speak to young people after Mass and encourage them to join the group – Cain will promote it and is very enthusiastic.
