A Brief history of St Malachy's Church, Kilclief



The first Church dedicated to St Malachy was erected in 1785 when the Parish Priest was Fr John Fitzsimons. It replaced several small Chapels in the area. Mass was also held in houses and fields. It cost £200 and was paid for by subscription. Over the altar there was a painting of the Crucifixion. The Church was capable of seating 280 people and there was a sundial on the walls.

A school was held in the Chapel then.

A gallery was added to increase its capacity in 1830.

The ruins of the original Church are still accessible through the Cemetery.

In 1925 a porch was built but was later replaced by a geometrical tower which housed the bell which was blessed by Fr Crossin on 15th August 1952 and was rung for the first time. Fr Crossin christened the new bell "Joseph".

Unfortunately the bell cracked and a new bell was fitted and blessed on 10th May 1956.

In 1968/69 an assessment was carried out on the Church which stated the roof and walls were in an advanced state of decay and it was decided the Church should be replaced. The site for the new Church was given to the Parish by Mrs Cultra of Ballywooden. The last Mass was celebrated in the old Church on 5th January 1969.



Mass was first celebrated in the new Church on 4th April 1971.

The Church was dedicated to St Malachy, blessed and officially opened by the Most Rev Dr Philbin on 16th May 1971.
